Mexico Mission 2018 Information Sheet

Dates: Sunday, August 5 – Saturday, August 11, 2018

Destination: San Quintin Valley, Baja, Mexico partnering with *One Life One Chance Ministries*

Purpose:

To share God's love and bring His hope to families in the San Quintin Valley through home builds, VBS, community meals and more. To connect with a local church. And all while building deeper relationships with our amazing church family.

Approximate cost (tax receiptable): \$895.00 CAD (\$425.00 CAD ages 8 - 10 yrs. [may be subject to change])

Project funds required to be raised: \$6500.00 CAD approx. (cost to build one home + outreach expenses)

Trip cost includes:

- Transportation + fuel - pickup and drop off @ San Diego airport and to/ from ministry sites
- Meals - in Mexico provided on the OLOCM Base at Los Olivos
- Accommodations at Los Olivos (tents or possibly dorms)
- Mexican highway tolls
- Mission fees and administration

Trip cost does not include:

- Airfare to/from San Diego
- Accident and medical insurance
- Spending money (snacks, tacos, souvenirs)
- Health shots

Your responsibilities:

- Valid Passport
- Out of country travel/ medical insurance + Trip cancellation/ interruption insurance for flights
- Flight to/from San Diego
- Health shots (Hepatitis A and B, Tetanus, Typhoid are highly recommended)
- Spending money (snacks, tacos and souvenirs)

Other Information:

- OLOCM will partner our team with a family and a church that they are partnered with in San Quintin. We will work with this church (and possibly other local ministries) to serve in the community. In the past, this has included children's activities in the community, serving meals, and more.
- As you pray about your participation, ask God if there is something that He would have us prepare for as we serve with the local church in San Quintin...maybe a way to foster deeper connection with the church and pastor we will be partnered with.
- Fundraising options may include: bottle drives, soup making and sales, silent auction, etc.

- If the financial cost is more than you feel you can afford, invite friends or extended family to participate with you by supporting you financially. Also, pray and if you feel strongly that God wants you to participate, trust that He will provide the means to go. Talk with us as well!
- Each team member will complete an application process (online forms)
- We will likely be arranging travel in 15 passenger vans with our own drivers
- Trip is open to all ages, but the recommended minimum age is 8 years old
- You don't need special skills to participate, just a heart to serve
- Building will be part of the trip, but there will be other opportunities as well
- Arrange your own travel to San Diego with other team members/families (we will help with coordinating hotel locations etc.)
- We'll hold a meeting early in the new year where we will solidify the team, plan fundraising etc.
- We will help with trip preparation with regular team meetings, resources and communication

Saturday	Aug. 11th	- travel back to San Diego
On or after	Aug. 12th	- fly/drive home
